Outdoor visits

- General Visitors (2 maximum) can visit outside but must be screened at North door near the storage units. Once screened go to the fenced gate to enter back yard. No rapid test required, mask on for full duration, no eye protection.
- You can have close contact with resident if you both are fully vaccinated.
- If you are not fully vaccinated, you can have a brief hug, and then continue to maintain 2m distance for duration.
- Must call ahead by 24hrs to book. Bookings occur with staff between the hrs. of 8-4 Monday- Friday. Can visit on weekend, but plan ahead. NO PETS PLEASE.

Absences

- Are permitted for medical appointments, compassionate/palliative, short term (essential or social), and temporary overnight.
- Temporary over night requires a PCR test and isolation upon return
- Short Term does not require approval but notification of when. (Only fully immunized residents can go out) A mask must be provided and worn as tolerated as well as reminders of the importance of hand hygiene and 2m distance.
- Residents need to be screened back in through the "screening" door upon return.
