### COVID 19 News Modified Stage 3 (Stage 2 Continuation for Grey Bruce LTC)

In the wonderful month of August we will look forward to being into **Stage 3 fingers crossed! NOT IN EFFECT AS OF YET.**

Some of the changes that will take place in stage 3 are below. Please keep in mind these are Ministry standards. Each LTC home is able to complete a risk assessment and make modifications.

- **Removing the limits on the number of visitors to homes:** exceptions remain in place where a resident is symptomatic, in isolation or resides in an outbreak area of the home. In these cases, only one caregiver can visit at a time and no general visitors are permitted. General visitors are still required to schedule visits in advance, with the home.
- **Dining:** buffet and family style dining are now allowed.
- **Absences:** all residents are allowed to go on absences regardless of immunization status. Exceptions to absences may be in place if the resident is on isolation or resides in an outbreak area of the home. Families should contact the home to discuss resident-specific absences.
- **Off-site excursions/group trips** can resume. These include group trips to shopping malls, attractions, etc. for residents.
- **Activities** such as singing and dancing will resume.

- Music programs are back again outside until we are allowed to have them return in the home.
- Bus trips have been put on hold again until Public Health Grey-Bruce deems them safe again for our residents.
