The *Local Health System Integration Act, 2006* (“LHSIA”) requires the Central East Local Health Integration Network (the “LHIN”) to notify a health service provider when the LHIN proposes to enter into, or amend, a service accountability agreement with that health service provider.

The LHIN hereby gives notice and advises CVH (No 6) - Port Perry Place (the “HSP”) of the LHIN’s proposal to amend each and every long-term care home service accountability agreement (as described in the LHSIA) currently in effect between the LHIN and the HSP (each a “SAA”).


